"NEW YEAR - NEW BLESSINGS"

Matthew 28 v 20 ".....; and lo, <u>I am with you always</u>, even to the end of the age. Amen."

Hello, and welcome to our January Newsletter. If you're reading this in December, Happy New Year when it comes – OR – if you're reading this in January – Happy New Year.

I feel sympathy for those who at some time, celebrated a New Year, then a year later, were glad to put that year behind them. We don't know what events will transpire for us as individuals in 2025, but we DO know that the Lord will continue to be with us.

Many of us take comfort from the Great Bible Truth in the above verse, where others add their caveat regarding its context within the Great Commission. This alludes to a conditional presence of the Lord, "so long as you do your bit" - yet nothing could be further from the Truth. Jesus promised the Comforter, The Holy Spirit who would "...abide with you for ever" (John 14v16) . You see, we have God's Presence, Salvation and Blessings, not by our good works, but by His Work on the Cross and Resurrection. This is the Underlying Blessing we take into 2025, empowering us to fulfil our part in The Above Great Commission.

So how do our good works in 2025 fit in? Well – let's start with God's Blessings through His undeserved Grace (Jesus deserved it for us). As we pray and are filled with the Holy Spirit, we know the Lord's Joy, which is our Strength (Nehemiah 8v10), and that <u>empowers</u> us to bring God's Blessings to others. That's my prayer of us as individuals, and a church. Jesus said ".. without me ye can do nothing" (John 15v5). Just as Jesus' Work <u>saved</u> us, let His Work <u>through</u> us be empowered by the Holy Spirit <u>in</u> us – during 2025.

How do we manifest God's Blessings in 2025?

- Realise that we already have the Blessings in Christ. Give Him Praise and Thanks.
- Continue to have our Individual Quiet Times, where we Pray, Read our Bibles and Listen to the Quiet Voice of the Holy Spirit.
- Be prayerful about open doors, our opportunities to show Christ's Love to others. When God shows us our particular "open doors" (and they're different for each one of us), let's pray for His Boldness and Wisdom, that we will be effective in that area of service, or word of encouragement.
- Continue to Fellowship at Church, where we can be blessed, and be a blessing.
- Be prayerful about our individual area of serving in the Church. For newcomers to church, my advice is Get to know others first, and build relationships. Then, as you get established and identify HEC as "home", be prayerful about how God wants you to support the fellowship, maybe even "starting small". Everything is Teamwork where we are "there for one another", and enjoy the Unity of the Spirit. We will then, as a church, bless those outside, and share Christ.
